### PAYMENT METHODS

Families/Students have two payment options when registering:

Option one:

Pay by Visa, MasterCard or American Express online at patspeak.com and click the Register Here for Learn to Ski & Ride Program found on the home page. You may also find the login page at patspeak.com/ski\_ride.htm.

Enter username "BOWREC" for BMS & BHS students or "BOWRECELEM" for elementary students. Password "BOWGIE". Please note username and password are case sensitive!

#### Option two:

Pay by check payable to Pats Peak. You can select the pay by check option. You will receive a confirmation page after hitting the "submit" button. You will be advised to print your confirmation page and submit with a check to the Bow Recreation Office. Deadline for payments by check will be November 10<sup>th</sup>. Payments received after this date a *LATE FEE* of \$25.00 will be applied and they will need to be brought directly to Pats Peak.

Pats Peak has a **NO REFUND**, **no exchange** policy on programs, rentals or perks. They will not refund the cost of the program to students who decide to participate in other activities after enrolling in the program. If the student is unsure if they are going to make a winter sports team, etc. or not, Pats Peak will accept applications for the program after the deadline date for an additional fee of \$25.00.

### **TRANSPORTATION**

Bus transportation (limited) is offered to children in Middle & High School. The fee is \$50.00 by either cash or check made payable to The Town of Bow.

Bus registration is separate from the Pat's Peak Registration. You *MUST* register for the bus by *NOV. 10<sup>th</sup>* through Parks & Recreation. If we have not met our minimum for busing by this date, we will not be able to offer the bus and everyone will need to transport their child (bus refunds will be given).

If your child can only do this program <u>if</u> bus transportation is available, please do not register them at Pat's Peak until after we can confirm the bus as Pat's Peak *WILL NOT* refund any money.

## **RENTALS**

Not sure if your child will need rentals? Pat's Peak will allow you to sign up for rentals at a later date.

# More Ski/Snowboard Information

**Bow Elementary School** students - <u>Lesson time is 4:30 p.m.</u> Parents are responsible for transporting their children. Parents are also responsible for their children during the program.

**Bow Memorial** and **High School** students - <u>Lesson time for those taking lessons is 5:30 p.m.</u> The ski bus will leave Bow High School at 3 p.m. and go to the Bow Memorial School to pick up Memorial School students. The bus will then depart the Bow Memorial School parking lot at 3:25 p.m. and return to the Memorial School by 7:15 p.m.

Anne-Marie Guertin, Bow Recreation's Program Coordinator, will be present at Pats Peak from 4 to 6:30 p.m. Chaperones will also be at Pats Peak. Look for the <u>Bow Recreation</u> table in the lodge if you need assistance.

**Parents who wish to ski** while their children are involved in the program may take advantage of Pats Peak's offering of a \$25 lift pass good from 3:30 p.m. until closing.

**BONUS DAY Information:** All youth enrolled in this ski/snowboard program will also receive a day pass at the end of the program good for one FREE day of skiing or snowboarding at Pats Peak as well as free rentals for those who rented during the program This FREE pass may be used from February 27th to the end of the end of Season 2012. You must provide your own transportation.
